disease	noun	질병	an illness	Although houseflies are important to life on Earth, they can sometimes spread disease.
feather	noun	깃털	the things on a bird that help it fly	Vultures are strange looking because they have no feathers on their heads.
garbage	noun	쓰레기	the material we throw away	Raccoons are scavengers that sometimes get into our garbage.
hunter	noun	사냥꾼	something which finds and kills for food	A lion is a hunter that sometimes becomes a scavenger to get food.
immune system	noun	면역 체계	part of your body which fights off sickness	Vultures need a strong immune system to keep from getting sick when they eat carrion.
infamous	adj	악명 높은	to be well-known in a bad way	The most infamous of all the scavengers is the rat.
landfill	noun	쓰레기 매립지	an area where garbage is mixed with the soil	When seagulls are not catching fish, they are often visiting landfills to get food.
microbe	noun	미생물	an organism which we cannot see with our eyes	It's a good thing we can't see the microbe scavengers because they look so scary.
pack	noun	단체로	a group	Hyenas travel in packs for food to eat.
predator	noun	포식자	an organism which hunts others	The turkey vulture is not a predator but only a scavenger.
rotting	adj	썩은	spoiled	Carrion is rotting meat that some scavengers like to eat.
scavenge	verb	쓰레기 더미를 뒤지다	to eat things that have died	Some animals will come into a yard to scavenge for food.
