zoo	noun	동물원	a place, usually in a city, where wild animals are kept in order to view, study or protect them	Most of the dogs that are getting out of their yards are near the zoo!
giraffe	noun	기린	a tall African animal with dark spots on its fur and an extremely long neck and legs	Someone had let the giraffes out, and they were running through the zoo!
cage	noun	우리, 새장	a structure of wire or metal bars used to contain birds or animals	The monkey is out of his cage!
monkey	noun	원숭이	a small brown animal with a long tail that is closely related to humans and typically lives in trees	Jacob saw a monkey nearby.
catch	verb	잡다	to take hold of	We need to try to catch him!
yard	noun	마당, 뜰	an outdoor area beside a building, often covered with grass	How did he get out of Mrs. Smith's yard?
near	prep	가까이에	close to	Most of the dogs that are getting out of their yards are near the zoo!
strange	adj	이상한, 낯선	different, unusual	Then they heard something strange.
