Northern Lights	noun	북극광	the aurora of the northern hemisphere	These are the Northern Lights.
glacier	noun	빙하	a very large body or mass of ice that moves slowly downward from a mountain valley	It is also surprising to see volcanoes and glaciers in the same place!
tortoise	noun	거북	an animal that eats plants, moves slowly, and has a hard protective frame	Lonesome George was the only giant Pinta tortoise left in the world.
reef	noun	암초	a line of rocks or sand that is below or just above the surface of the ocean	The whole reef is alive!
canyon	noun	협곡	a deep and narrow valley	The Grand Canyon is a big hole.
rainforest	noun	열대우림	a wet forest, where it rains almost every day	The Amazon rainforest is another wonder filled with plants and animals.
stone	noun	돌	a piece of rock	Stonehenge is a circle of huge stones in England.
pyramid	noun	피라미드	a massive, stone structure that has a square base and four three-sided walls that meet at the top to form a point	Probably the most famous wonders made by people long ago are the pyramids.
dam	noun	댐	a structure similar to a wall that is built across a river to prevent the flow of water	Now the country has modern dams.
vertical	adj	수직의	going up and down	Burj Khalifa has been called a vertical city.
