monkey	noun	원숭이	a small brown animal with a long tail that is closely related to humans and typically lives in trees	These monkeys like bananas.
tail	noun	꼬리	the movable part of an animal's body which grows from its back	Tadpoles have long tails and look a little like small fish.
hang	verb	걸다, 매달다	to position something in a raised position so that the top part is fixed	The lamp is hanging outside the restaurant.
thumb	noun	엄지손가락	the wide, short finger on the side of the hand that helps a person hold or GRASP an object	The thickest finger on your hand is called the thumb.
opposite	adj	반대의	being totally different from	The post office stands opposite to the police station.
pinch	verb	꼬집다	to squeeze or compress between the finger and thumb	I pinched myself to see if I was dreaming.
troop	noun	병력, 군대	a group of soldiers, especially horse	She was the only soldier from her troop to survive. The rest were killed in the battle.
pest	noun	해충, 유해 동물	an insect or small animal that ruins plants or food supplies	Mosquitoes can truly be a pest after a humid rainy day.
coconut	noun	코코넛	a very large nut with a hairy shell, which has white flesh and milky juice inside it	My favorite to do is eat coconuts.
mirror	noun	거울	a smooth piece of glass that creates a reflection to look at	I use the mirror to help me put on my contact lenses.
