| stalactite | noun | 종유석 | an icicle-shaped mineral deposit formed from the dripping of mineral-rich water | There were carvings everywhere and giant stalactites. |
| cave | noun | 동굴 | a large opening in the ground or in the side of a hill | Many bats flew out of the caves. |
| monster | noun | 괴물 | an imaginary creature that is often large and frightening | Frankenstein is said to be the first science fiction novel about a mad scientist creating a monster out of dead body parts. |
| string | noun | 끈, 줄 | thick thread | The kite is tied to a long string. |
| tie | verb | 묶다, 매다 | to attach, join or close something, with string, wire or a similar item | Sam can tie his shoelaces together. |
| smile | verb | 미소짓다 | to make the corners of your mouth turn up or show your teeth in an expression of happiness | I gave my Mother a flower and she smiled. |
| hide | verb | 숨다 | to go and stay somewhere that hard to see or find | The leopard could hide in the sand. |
| hairy | adj | 털이 많은 | covered with a lot of hair | When Bottom had a donkey’s head, he said it felt hairy. |
