salamander	noun	도롱뇽	a small amphibian with moist skin that looks like a lizard	The children walked through the woods in search of a salamander.
caecilian	noun	나사	a worm like amphibian that lives in the ground	I saw a caecilian, but I thought it was an earthworm.
newt	noun	영원류	an amphibian with short legs and a long tail which is related to the salamander	The newt will lay its eggs in the pond.
hatch	verb	부화하다	to break open for a baby to come out of	The children watched as the egg hatched.
tadpole	noun	올챙이	a baby frog or toad that has a round body, gills, and a tail	We found thousands of tadpoles in a small pond in the mountains.
crawl	verb	기어가다	to move slowly with the body close to the ground	The baby crawled across the floor to her father.
webbed	adj	물갈퀴가 있는	having toes that are joined together by skin	Ducks have webbed feet.
gummy	adj	고무진이 묻은	sticky	The gummy dough stuck to the table.
axolotl	noun	아홀로틀	a salamander that lives in water	We went to Mexico to see an axolotl.
