talent agency	noun	탤런트 양성 기관	a company that hires actors and tries to find them jobs	The talent agency helped Brad get his first role in a movie.
studio	noun	스튜디오	a large building where movies are shot	Some of the scenes were shot in the studio instead of on location.
shoot	verb	영화를 찍다	to record on film	They will try to shoot the entire movie in three months.
edit	verb	수정하다, 편집하다	to make changes to something before the final product is released	When they edited the movie, they cut out some of the scenes.
credits	noun	영화를 만든이 들	a long list of the people who worked on a movie	We always stay to watch the credits at the end of the movie.
script	noun	대본	a story written for a movie	The actor studied the script and memorized his lines.
crew	noun	집단	a group of people working together on a project	The crew cheered when the director said, "It's a wrap!"
director	noun	감독	the person who tells the actors and other people working on a movie what to do	The actors listened to the director as she told them what to do.
