claw	noun	발톱	one of the sharp, curved nails on the toes of an animal	Tigers and lions have claws to protect themselves and hunt.
crawl	verb	엎드려 기다	to move with the body on or close to the ground	Seals have to crawl on land.
flipper	noun	지느러미발, 물갈퀴	a wide, flat arm used for swimming by certain animals like seals and turtles	Some mammals use flippers for swimming.
glide	verb	미끄러지듯 움직이다	to come down slowly in the air	Flying squirrels can't really fly, but they glide through the air.
hibernate	verb	동면하다, 겨울잠을 자다	to go into a long, deep sleep during winter	Some animals hibernate in the winter.
hollow	adj	텅 빈	empty on the inside	The horns of animals are hollow.
graceful	adj	우아한	to move in a beautiful way	Seals are very graceful in the water.
reptile	noun	파충류	a cold-blooded animal belonging to a group that includes turtles, lizards, and snakes	Reptiles lie in the sun to keep warm.
shed	verb	허물, 껍질 등을 벗다	to lose fur or skin	In summer, some mammals shed their heavy fur.
species	noun	종	a group of animals or plants that are similar	People are one of 5,000 species of animals on earth.
spine	noun	척추, 등뼈	one of the short, sharp growths on an animal	Hedgehogs have spines to protect themselves.
spray	verb	뿌리다, 분사하다	to push out liquid in a stream of many small drops	Skunks spray a liquid to protect themselves.
stinky	adj	악취가 나는	smelling very bad	The liquid that skunks spray is very stinky.
