beak	noun	새의 부리	the hard mouth part of a bird	The giant birds were dangerous because of their metal beaks.
capture	verb	잡다	catch	Hercules had to capture a deer and a dog.
chase	verb	뒤쫓다	to follow and try to catch something	Hercules chased the deer for one year before he caught it.
claw	noun	발톱	the curved, sharp part of an animal's toe	The birds were so big they could pick up children with their claws.
dragon	noun	용	a giant monster that breathes fire	Hercules used a poisonous arrow to kill the dragon.
flock	noun	무리	a large group of birds	The flock of dangerous birds lived by a lake.
grave	adj	중대한, 중요한	not funny at all	The dangerous bull caused the king grave trouble when Hercules let it go.
hay	noun	건초	dry grass that is fed to cows, horses, and sheep	The barn was full of hay that smelled terrible.
hero	noun	영웅	a person admired for brave or great acts	To the Greeks, Hercules was the greatest hero who ever lived.
noisemaker	noun	조음기	an instrument that makes noise	When the birds heard the noisemaker, they flew into the air.
stir	verb	자극하다	to create by action	Hera hated Hercules, so she stirred up hatred in the Amazon women.
underworld	noun	암흑가, 지옥	the place of dead souls in Greek stories	Hercules had to go into the underworld to capture the dog Cerberus.
warrior	noun	전사	a strong fighter	The women warriors of the Amazon fought against Hercules and his men.
