breeze	noun	미풍	a gentle wind	Work was easier because of the cool breeze.
cane	noun	줄기, 지팡이	the hard stem of a plant like bamboo	Malaya planted the broken flute so that sugar cane would grow.
chase	verb	뒤쫓다, 추적하다	to follow and try to catch something	Malaya chased the crows away from her baskets.
claw	noun	발톱	the curved, sharp part of an animal’s toe	The birds picked up her basket with their claws.
flap	verb	파닥거리다	to move up and down	The crows flapped their wings, so Malaya was afraid of them.
harvest	verb	수확하다	to collect ripe plants grown on a farm	After the sugar cane grew tall, the three of them harvested it.
lowlands	noun	저지대	areas of land that are below sea level	The place where the honey was harvested was the lowlands.
magic	noun	마술, 마법	the power to do impossible things	The dog knew of a place that had magic honey.
mango	noun	망고	a tropical fruit with yellow and red skin	Malaya wanted to eat mangos because they were sweet.
peso	noun	페소 (멕시코의 화폐단위)	a unit of money in Mexico and the Philippines	The magic honey only cost two pesos.
poke	verb	찌르다, 찌시다	to push something thin and pointed into someone	Bantay’s rough fur poked Malaya, so she had a hard time sleeping.
precious	adj	소중한	very special or important	Bantay broke her mother’s precious flute.
snap	verb	딱 부러뜨리다	to try to bite quickly and suddenly	The dog made loud snapping noises in the dark.
