eventually	ad	결국, 마침내	at a later time, in the end	Eventually, the two were able to come down from the tree.
flap	noun	덮개	a flat piece of material that is attached to something on one side	The teepee had a flap for a door.
full-grown	adj	완전히 자란	having grown to the biggest size you will be	The full-grown buffalo was a huge animal.
herd	noun	떼, 무리	a group of animals	Buffalo were easy to find because they traveled in large herds.
hide	noun	가죽	the skin of an animal	Yellow Hawk used a piece of buffalo hide to draw a map.
moccasin	noun	모카신	a soft, leather shoe	As soon as he woke up, Bear Heart put on his soft moccasins.
pit	noun	구덩이	a hole in the ground	The men of the village used a fire pit to cook food.
roast	verb	굽다	to cook with a dry heat	They roasted a big piece of meat over the fire.
satchel	noun	책가방	a small bag	Bear Heart was carrying food in his satchel.
snort	verb	코를 킁킁거리다	to force air through the nose, making a loud sound	When the buffalo saw Yellow Hawk and Bear Heart, it snorted angrily.
teepee	noun	원뿔형 천막	a type of home, similar to a tent	The Dakota tribe lived in teepees.
