cafeteria	noun	구내식당	a large room in a school or other building where food is served	I had to find someone to eat lunch with in the cafeteria.
clap	verb	박수 치다	applauding a performance by striking your hands together	After I finished playing the song, the other students clapped for me.
coach	noun	코치	a person who trains an athlete or a team of athletes	The coach put me on Hannah's team.
dial	noun	숫자판	a small disk with numbers marked on it	I turned the dial on the lock to open it.
gym	noun	체육관	a room for indoor sports	I put on my gym uniform for the volleyball game.
ignore	verb	무시하다	to know something or someone is there, but not to do anything about it or say anything	The teacher was the only one in class who didn't ignore me.
interrupt	verb	방해하다	to stop a person from doing or saying something	I knew that if I interrupted the girls, they would stare at me.
locker	noun	개인 사물함	a small compartment that can be locked	I walked down the hall to find my locker.
orchestra	noun	오케스트라	a group of people playing musical instruments	My orchestra class was the most fun.
podium	noun	지휘대	a small platform for the conductor of an orchestra	The teacher tapped his baton on the podium so that we would look at him.
stare	verb	응시하다	to look at intently	The other students just stared at me without speaking.
