arctic	adj	북극의	the area around Earth’s North Pole	Some plants can live in the Arctic.
claw	noun	발톱	a sharp nail at the end of some animals’ paws	The ermine uses its sharp claws to dig holes in the snow.
cycle	noun	순환, 주기	a series of events that happen over and over again	The cycle of melting ice and increasing heat is a problem for Earth.
disappear	verb	사라지다	to no longer exist	Without krill for food, many Antarctic animals would disappear.
freeze	verb	얼다	to become so cold that death is possible	If penguins did not work together, they could not stay alive in the freezing Antarctic weather.
government	noun	정부	a system that controls the economic and social process of a country	Young people can write letters to the government to help the problem of global warming.
global	adj	세계적인	referring to the whole world	Global warming is causing an increase in the temperature at the Arctic.
hare	noun	토끼	any of various swift long-eared type of mammals, for example a rabbit	The coat of the hare changes to white in the winter.
iceberg	noun	빙산	a very large piece of floating ice	Icebergs can be found in the colder oceans near the Earth’s poles.
krill	noun	크릴새우	a small sea animal that is similar to shrimp	Krill can be found in oceans everywhere.
lemming	noun	나그네쥐	a rodent belonging to the family, which includes rats and mice	The lemming can easily dig a hole for a nest with its strong legs and claws.
migration	noun	이주, 이동	the journey that some animals make every year	The migration of the arctic tern is the longest of any bird.

oxygen	noun	산소	the gas that animals and people need to survive	The icefish does not have much oxygen in its blood.
