axon	noun	신경 세포의 축삭 돌기	the part of a neuron that carries signals away from the cell	The job of the axon is to send signals away from the brain cell.
behavior	noun	행동	the way that a person acts	Our behavior is controlled by the front lobe of the brain.
brain stem	noun	뇌간	the stem-like part at the base of the brain that controls body activities like breathing and digestion	The brain stem is deep inside the brain at the base of the neck, and it helps keep you alive.
cerebellum	noun	소뇌	a smaller part of the brain below the cerebrum that controls muscles	The cerebellum is also divided into two halves but is much smaller than the cerebrum.
cerebrum	noun	대뇌	the largest and main part of the brain, divided into two halves	The two halves of the cerebrum make up the largest part of the brain.
digestion	noun	소화	the process of changing food that is eaten to a form that the body can use	Breathing and digestion are controlled by the brain stem.
glial cell	noun	교질 세포	a type of brain cell that supports the neurons	Glial cells help neurons by cleaning up around the neurons.
lobe	noun	엽	one of the four sections of the cerebrum	The cerebrum has four lobes that control different body activities.
nerve	noun	신경	a long, thin part that carries signals between the brain and other parts of the body	There are billions of nerve cells inside our brain.
nutrient	noun	영양소	a substance that is needed in order to live and grow	In addition to cleaning up around neurons, glial cells also bring nutrients to them.
organ	noun	기관	a group of body tissues working together	The brain is one of the body's organs.

papyrus	noun	파피루스	a paper-like material made from a certain kind of grass	The first medical writing about the brain was on a piece of papyrus.
reason	verb	추론해내다	to think about facts and make judgments	Our brain allows us to reason and figure out things.
