| shark | noun | 상어 | a large and dangerous fish with sharp teeth | A shark is a large, dangerous fish that lives in the sea. |
| fin | noun | 지느러미 | one of the flat, thin body parts of a fish that sticks out and helps guide it through water | The tail fin on this airplane is broken. |
| hunt | noun | 사냥하다 | to search for wild animals to kill, usually for food | Lions sometimes hunt alone. |
| tooth | noun | 이, 치아 | any of the hard, white objects in the mouth, used for eating food | My sister lost her first tooth yesterday. |
| egg | noun | 알, 달걀 | a round object that is produced by a female bird and contains a baby bird, often eaten by humans | This type of birds lay their eggs in the summer. |
| pup | noun | 늑대, 여우의 새끼 | a young dog or the young of other animals, eg the seal, wolf and rat | A young fox is a cub or a pup. |
| catch | verb | 붙잡다 | to stop something and not let it go, like an animal | The cat climbs up the tree to catch a bird. |
| ocean | noun | 대양, 해양 | a large body of salt water that covers most of the surface of the earth | I can swim in the ocean. |
| cold-blooded | adj | 냉혈의 | having cold blood in animals whose body temperature is not internally regulated | Snakes are cold-blooded animals. |
| endangered | adj | 멸종될 위기에 이른 | at risk of extinction | We all need to help in protecting endangered species. |
