instructor	noun	교사, 가르치는 사람	a person who teaches, usually as a job	The driving instructor told the student to stop the car.
climber	noun	등산가	a person who climbs rocks and mountains as a sport or hobby	Korean climbers have reached the top of the Himalayan Mountains.
cliff	noun	남떠러지, 벼랑	a surface of rock, ice, or earth that extends downward very sharply	From the top of the cliff, he could see the whole valley below.
crevice	noun	균열, 갈라진 틈	a narrow gap in the surface of something	He placed his foot in the crevice and pushed his body up the rock.
steep	adj	가파른, 경사가 급한	being almost straight up and down	I was very scared during the slow, steep climb to the top of the roller coaster.
rope	noun	새끼, 밧줄	a strong and thick string that is made by wrapping together many thinner strings	You need a strong piece of rope to tie the boxes together.
gear	noun	장치, 도구	a device necessary for a special purpose	He will bring some good camping gear for the trip.
harness	noun	벨트	a set of straps for fastening something to a person's body	Make sure your harness is tight around your body.
karabiner	noun	금속 고리	a special clip to hold the harness and rope	A karabiner is usually made of a light metal like aluminum.
slip off	idiom	미끄러져 떨어지다	to slide down	The tree was wet, so he slipped off when he tried to climb it.
grip	verb	꽉 잡다, 움켜잡다	to hold something in your hand very firmly	It is a good idea to grip a bar or a seat when riding a bus.
sweaty	adj	땀이 나는	covered with sweat	The players were tired and sweaty after the game.
competition	noun	경쟁	the act or process of trying to win or be better than others at something	The competition to enter Harvard University is always very strong.
