reptile	noun	파충류 동물	a cold-blooded animal belonging to a group that includes turtles, lizards, and snakes	The Komodo Dragon is one of the largest reptiles in the world.
flipper	noun	오리발	a broad, flat limb without fingers used for swimming	Penguins use their flippers to swim and crawl on the snow.
lay	verb	알을 낳다	to bring something forth	Some snakes lay their eggs in caves.
dig	verb	파다, 땅을 파다	to move soil using one's hands or a tool in order to make a hole	The dog digs a hole in the ground and puts a bone in it.
drag	verb	끌다	to pull with great force, effort, or difficulty someone or something that is difficult to move	The farmer is trying to drag the pig out of the pen.
incubate	verb	(알을) 품다, 부화하다	to keep bird eggs warm by sitting on them until the baby bird is ready to be born	Bird eggs incubate in the nests, while crocodile eggs incubate in the sand.
release	verb	석방하다, 해방시키다	to free a person or thing from a limited or locked place, such as a prison, a cage or a container	The fisherman released the fish back into the sea.
measure	verb	재다, 측정하다	to determine the size or amount of something or someone	I measured the furniture to check its size.
hatch	verb	부화하다	to be born or come out from an egg	After the egg hatched, a small turtle came out.
weigh	verb	~의 무게를 달다	to use a device or machine to measure the weight of someone or something	She weighed the cat on a scale.
strangle	verb	목졸라 죽이다, 질식사키다	to kill by squeezing the throat	He strangled the poor man to death.
ranger	noun	무장 순찰 대원	a type of official who works to manage and protect an area such as a park or forest	She is one of the rangers of the Yellowstone National Park.
destroy	verb	파괴하다, 부수다	to damage something so that it cannot be repaired	The terrorists destroyed the camp with a bomb.
