block	verb	막다, 방해하다	to prevent something or someone from reaching something or someone else	The police blocked the street for the parade.
feed	verb	먹이를 주다	to give someone or something food	The visitors to the zoo should not feed the animals.
build	verb	짓다, 건축하다	to make something by putting separate parts together	We are going to build a tree house in our backyard.
predator	noun	포식자	one that kills or destroys	Predators usually hunt for their prey in silence.
gather	verb	모이다, 집결하다	to come together in a group	The students gather in the schoolyard every morning before classes start.
cling	verb	꼭 붙잡다	to hold together or stay united	I saw two small birds cling to the cage door.
branch	noun	나뭇가지	a part of a tree that grows out of its central section	There are many ants climbing up the tree branches.
claw	noun	갈고리 발톱	a long, sharp, and usually curved nail of an animal	An owl catches small animals with its sharp claws.
hollow	adj	속이 빈	having a hole or nothing inside	The brown squirrel lives in a hollow tree trunk in the park.
sharp	adj	날카로운, 뾰족한	having a thin edge or point that is able to cut or make a hole in something	We must always be careful when using a sharp knife.
vine	noun	덩굴	plant that grows on trees or walls	Tarzan used vines to swing from tree to tree.
beak	noun	부리	the hard part of a bird's mouth that is usually pointed and curved	An eagle uses its sharp, curved beak to kill its prey.
