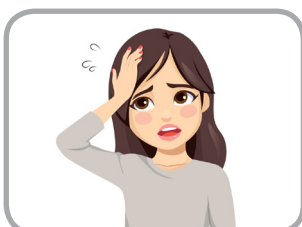

It is formed with **have/has been verb + ing**.

- So there you are. **I've been looking** for you.
- He's tired because he **has been working** for hours.

A: I've been playing a game with my friends .

A: Because it has been raining all day .
