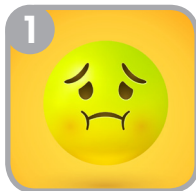

Adverbs of Manner

Adverbs of manner describe how someone does something or how something happens. Most of them end in *-ly*. They can go in different places in a sentence.

- The full moon shone **brightly** over the sea. (*after main verb, no object*)
- The female leatherback turtle was **calmly** dropping eggs. (*before main verb*)
- The female leatherback turtle was dropping eggs **calmly**. (*after object*)
- The female leatherback turtle was dropping calmly eggs.
(*NOT between verb and object*)

More adverbs of manner: *angrily, badly, beautifully, bravely, carefully, cheerfully, correctly, easily, happily, kindly, loudly, perfectly, quickly, quietly, rudely, seriously, shyly, stupidly*
