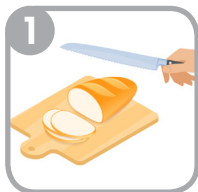

adjective + *that*-clause

You can use an **adjective + *that*-clause** to talk about people’s opinions and feelings. (Leaving out *that* doesn’t change the meaning.)

- I’m so glad (***that***) ***you were here to do this with me.***
- She felt sure ***that she knew the right answer.***
- They’re afraid ***poachers will get some of the eggs.***

More adjectives with this pattern: *amazed, annoyed, aware, concerned, confident, correct, delighted, disappointed, glad, happy, pleased, sad, shocked, sorry, surprised, upset, worried*
